6	Resolving Conflict	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To learn the prophetic/Prophet's (PBUH) method of resolving conflict • To learn that good citizens deal with conflicts in a peaceful and law abiding way

7	Law and Order	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To explore the importance of Law and Order in society • To learn that Islam requires Muslims to be law abiding citizens
8	Tolerance, Respect and Love for Humanity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To learn the differences between the qualities of tolerance, respect and love and their importance in Islam • To understand that these qualities also make a good citizen
9	Living in a Multifaith Society	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To learn that citizenship and Islam teaches respect and tolerance for people of all faiths or of no faith.
10	Volunteering and Giving Charity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand the both Islam and citizenship teaches us to volunteer and give charity.
11	Being a British Muslim	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand we can Muslim and British. • To understand that Islam recognises different nations and tribe. • To understand that Islam teaches that no nation is better than another but the best are those who have more “Taqwaa” (piety).
12	Community Cohesion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To learn what Community Cohesion is. • To explore the Islamic teachings regarding living and working with others.
13	Active Citizenship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand the nature of active citizenship. • To learn that Active Citizenship is a part of the Islamic tradition.

14	Islam and the Environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To learn that as Muslims and as citizens we have responsibility to protect the environment around us.
15	Diversity in Islam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To learn that good Muslims do not look down on other Muslims regardless of the group they belong to. • To understand that Islam encourages us to celebrate similarities and respect differences.
16	Equality Issues :Roles of Men and Women	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand what Islam says about the role of men and women in the modern world. • To learn that both men and women are equal citizens.
17	Dealing with Racism	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand what is racism. • To understand how racism is different from bullying. • To understand that Islam condemns all forms of racism and teaches equality for all humanity.
